Additional details

Our baseline year is the period from Jul 2024 to Jun 2025. Although we have considered our sustainability as a company in the past, this was the first year in which we have conducted an accurate, compliant carbon footprint with the support of a third party (Seedling).

This footprint has been conducted in full compliance with the GHG Protocol, including all of Scope 1, 2 and 3. The categories required for Scope 3 are broken out below, as well as optional categories not included under the requirements.

A large proportion of our emissions sit within employee commuting and our supply chain. In both cases we are actively improving the data quality and coverage (e.g. by extending a commuting survey out to cover more of our on-site workers), and expect to update the numbers for these categories in the baseline year once this exercise is complete.

Please also note that Supreme Facilities Ltd and Supreme Guarding Ltd share the same operations, sites and management team. They have shared operational control and data cannot be distinguished between each entity. As a result, per the GHG Protocol, we have used a combined organisational boundary, treating both entities as a group for the purposes of carbon accounting.

Emission reduction targets

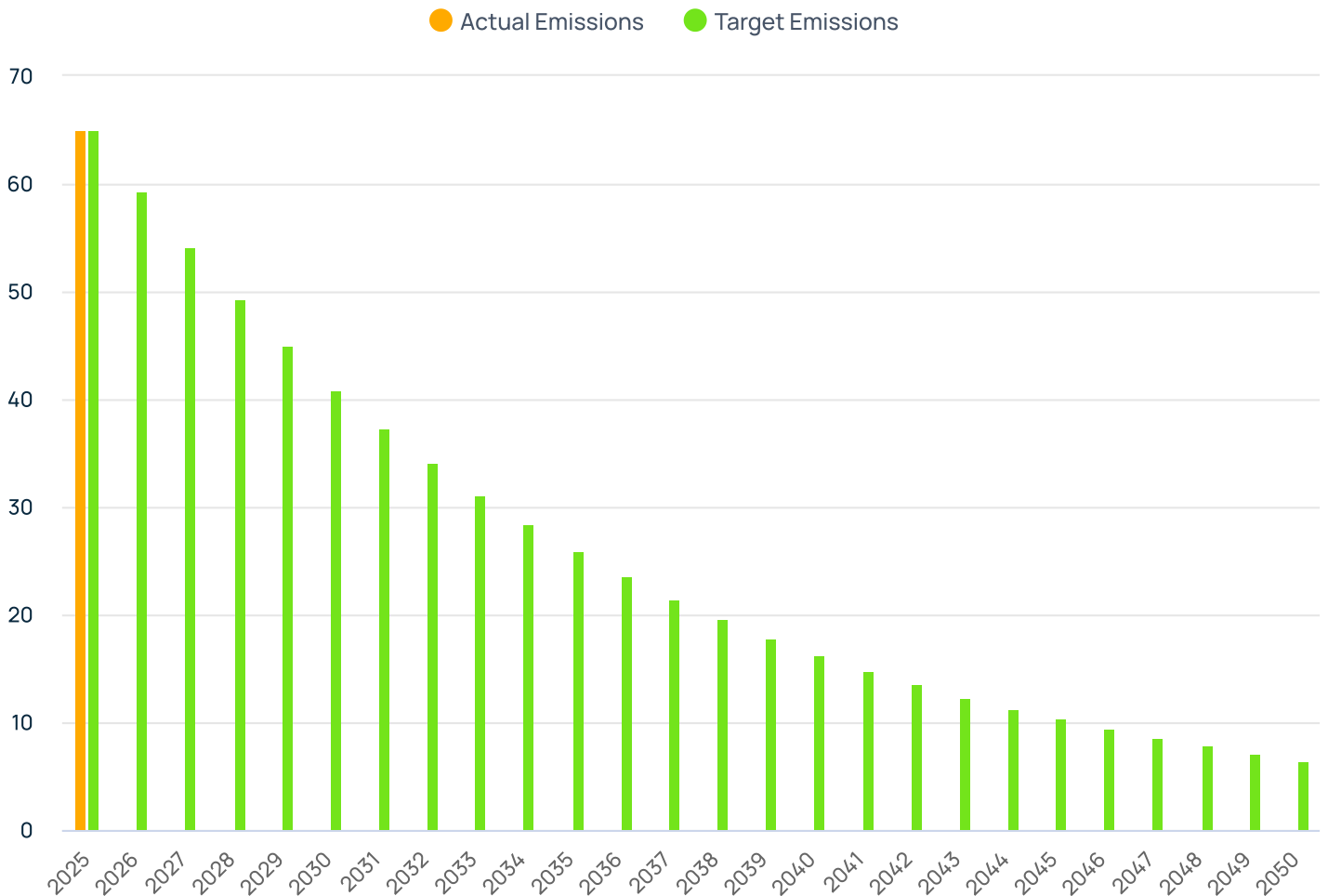
This section outlines our emission reduction targets and progress to date

Our targets

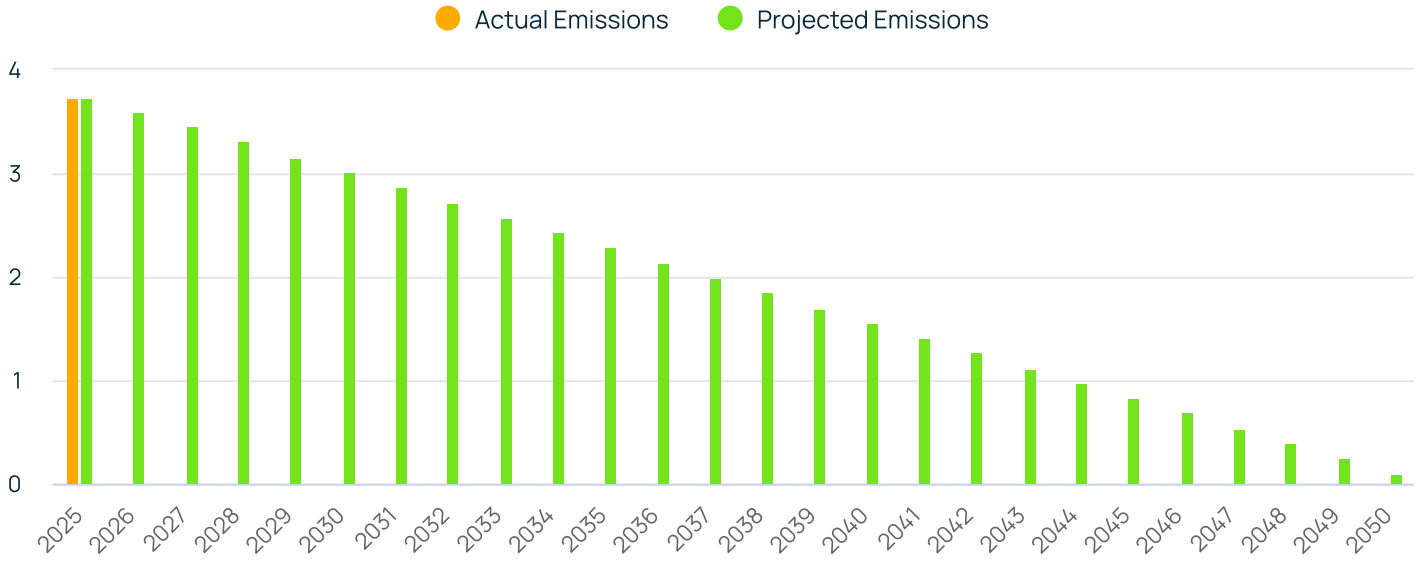
In line with the SBTi Corporate Net Zero standard, we are targeting a 90% reduction in our absolute Scope 1 and 2 emissions (with the remainder being offset). This is a science-based target which aligns to the global goal to limit global warming to 1.5oC. In order to reach this goal, we track our progress against the annual reduction required to stay on the pathway to Net Zero. This is presented in the graph below.

In addition, to cover Scope 3 we have set an intensity-based target, also in line with the SBTi. This reflects the fact that as we grow, Scope 3 emissions will likely scale with employee activity, so this provides a clear and comparable metric to use for tracking progress.

Explore switching company cars to EVs

Aim to recycle all general office waste at our sites

Conduct annual energy efficiency audits at our sites

Aim to recycle all food waste at our sites

Explore switching company diesel vans to electric

Investigate sustainability of paper and switch to recycled paper if possible

Explore the possibility of provide electricity requirements at sites via installation of solar panels
